

## **Standards-Based Grading Snapshot**

We are launching **standards-based grading** for 2022-23.

### Standards-based grading:

- is a system of assessing and reporting that describes students' progress in relation to specific learning targets (skills and concepts)
- separates what students know (concepts) and are able to do (skills) from how they behave and other non-achievement measures
- allows teachers to provide specific and individualized feedback to students on their mastery of learning standards

## Health & Safety

## **BUGS COVID Safety Policies**

We have just received new guidance from the <u>NYC DOE for 22-23</u>, but there are not major changes. We are confident that continuing our testing and other safety measures will continue to keep our community safe.

- BUGS Vaccination: all staff are vaccinated, and we expect student vax % to be high (21-22SY was ~90%)
- COVID testing: weekly at BUGS, kits sent home for classroom exposure
- Ventilation, air purification, good hand hygiene will all continue!
- Masks available to all students, staff & visitors.

## **Quarantine & Isolation**

- Individuals do not need to quarantine after exposure, unless they have symptoms
- We hope to be able to have home test kits available to be sent home as needed
- If a person is infected with COVID (whether vaxed or not), they must isolate for 5 days
- We will notify the DOH as required of positive cases and follow their guidance about quarantine and isolation

## **Strategies to Stay Healthy**

- Stay up to date on <u>all</u> vaccinations
  - 6th: TDaP
  - 7th: Meningococcal
- Stay home when you're feeling sick
- Wash your hands properly and cough into your elbow
- Wear a mask if you're not feeling well, have a cough or sniffles, or if someone in your family is sick
- If you even think you might have COVID, test at home!
  We can send home a kit if you need one.



## **BUGS School Safety Policies**

- BUGS works with the Diocese to ensure we have our own security guard at all times, in addition to School Safety Officers working with our DOE neighbors.
- The <u>General Response Protocol (GRP)</u> is designed to provide direction that schools will take when an emergency incident occurs. BUGS works in unison with our neighboring schools, M.S. 442 and K280, as well as with our landlord the Brooklyn Diocese to coordinate efforts and emergency responses.
- The Bishop Ford Campus will conduct 12 drills a year. BUGS students and staff receive training on the GRP and the schools specific responses.
- In the event our school needs to take a legitimate GRP response, families will be notified in a timely manner. In the event of an emergency, lockdown or shelter in, absolutely no one will be allowed in or out of the building for any reason. Do not attempt to pick up your child during this time.

### Your COVID "Do Nows":

- 1. Share your student's most updated COVID vaccination status using this short <u>Vaccination Status Form</u>.
- 2. If you haven't done so previously, give consent for your student to participate in COVID testing at BUGS using the **Consent Form**.
  - a. If you are not sure whether you have completed the consent form, or if you only need to update information (contact, insurance), please complete this <u>Google Form</u> instead.
- 3. **COVID ENTRY TESTING:** All students should be tested within 3 days prior to their first day onsite at BUGS. See COVID email for more details. Home test kits will be available at the PTA picnic on 8/25!
  - a. Students are not required to show proof of negative test prior to school.

## **Technology: Cell Phones & Chromebooks**

### **Cell Phones**

- Student cell phones will be collected during advisory by a staff member
- Phones will be locked and stored until end of day (even during lunch and recess)
- Families should contact main office if they need to reach students during the school day
- Phones will be returned end of day & prior to dismissal

### Chromebooks

- Students will be provided with a BUGS Chromebook for their use during the school day only.
- Personal laptops/tablets are not allowed in class for any reason.

Families are notified through TeacherEase email and texts of any same day schedule changes or other time sensitive information.

### Meals



- During Orientation, students will eat in advisory groups; they will be taken outside for lunch by advisors
- Starting in September, we will begin our off campus lunch privileges. We will implement a grade level roll out starting with 8th grade. 7th and 6th will join by the end of October. Exact dates to be determined
- Breakfast and lunch grab and go option always available
- Cafeteria/recess yard


